Fine Motor Skills - Milestones	
Age	Developmental Milestones
0–3 months	<ul> <li>Brings hands to mouth</li> <li>Moves arms</li> <li>May swing arms at toys</li> <li>Hands start to open more</li> </ul>
3-6 months	<ul> <li>Holds small object in hand (without thumb tucked in hand)</li> <li>Holds hands together</li> <li>Reaches for toys with both arms</li> <li>Pushes up on arms when on tummy</li> <li>Briefly holds a toy like a rattle</li> <li>Follows objects with eyes in all directions</li> </ul>
6-9 months	<ul> <li>Shakes and bangs rattles</li> <li>Brings toys to mouth</li> <li>Uses a raking grasp</li> <li>Transfers objects from one hand to the other</li> <li>Keeps hands open and relaxed most of the time</li> <li>Starting to have the ability to pick up small foods like Cheerios</li> </ul>
9-12 months 12-18 months	<ul> <li>Able to release an object voluntarily</li> <li>Gives toy to a caregiver when asked</li> <li>Bangs two toys together</li> <li>Turns pages of a book a few pages at a time</li> <li>Begins to put objects into a container</li> <li>Points to objects</li> <li>Stacks 2 blocks</li> <li>Claps hands together</li> <li>Puts objects and toys into containers</li> <li>Waves goodbye</li> <li>Uses both hands to play</li> <li>Can isolate index finger with other fingers closed</li> <li>Scribbles with a crayon</li> <li>Beginning to use a spoon and cup</li> </ul>

18-24 months	<ul> <li>Can build a block tower using 3-4 blocks</li> <li>Puts rings on a ring stacker</li> <li>Turns pages of a book one at a time</li> <li>Begins holding crayons with finger tips and thumb</li> </ul>
2-5 years	<ul> <li>Likes to draw; holds crayon with fingers</li> <li>Able to imitate designs like a circle or a cross</li> <li>Has hand control to build block towers</li> <li>Can string beads on a shoelace</li> <li>Able to make a Cheerio or macaroni necklace</li> <li>Beginning with scissor skills</li> <li>Scissor skills show improvement - Able to cut simple shapes</li> <li>Able to do simple puzzles (6-10 pieces)</li> </ul>
